Paint Project Updates

After the paint project started we found our rotted wood issue was considerably more extensive than first thought. When gutters were removed the wood around and behind the gutters showed years of wood rot and had to be replaced. The storage door trim, door jams and interior support pieces had extensive damage on all 87 homes and also had to be replaced. Lowe's has given a reduced price for a new storage door of \$240 installed with \$40 lock assembly charge. The good news is even though we are experiencing financial overages for this project, we have not had to go the route of a Special Assessment. Not many Associations experience a near \$300,000 improvement project without an assessment – but so far we are the exception!

We are approaching the final stretch and hope to have completed wood repair/replacement, painting and new gutters by mid June. Yes, it's been an inconvenience for many of us, however, this complete overhaul has garnered a lot of compliments from owners - Realtors have expressed how financially advantageous it is and we are making our homes more sellable. Recent homes have sold in only a day or two and are selling at great prices!

There is an ongoing list comprised of owners issues and if reported you will be added to the list. We want ALL issues completed and your satisfaction ensured prior to Lowe's final payment.

Front door edges will be painted. Lowes will be here two Saturdays (for the convenience of those who are working) in June. The front doors requiring sandblasting will also be sandblasted and painted in June.

Carports

Those of you with carport roof leaks - we haven't forgotten you and we appreciate your patience. Roofs will be replaced quarterly starting in the fall. Leaking roofs will be replaced first.

<u>Trees</u>

We had to cut down and remove another 22 pine trees in April. This leaves us with approximately 395 pines still standing. As mentioned in previous newsletters, the bore/beetle killing our pine trees can not be eradicated and they are killing pines all over the County. We have had to double our tree budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 and anticipate the loss of another 100+ pines. Pinellas County is working with us regarding replacement trees and we are thankful they are not currently insisting we plant a new tree for

If a dead tree is close to your home, please report to Beverly at Ameri-Tech bNeubecker@ameritechmail.com (727-726-8000x302) to arrange for our Arborist to inspect and have dead tree removed during the next scheduled cutting. Please note, per Pinellas County only dead trees can be removed. No live trees can be cut down.
