While walking if she sees an infraction of Woods Landing Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&Rs) a letter is sent to the owner. The top three issues are storage of items in the carport (other than vehicles), trash spilled from pecking birds and trash cans not put away. With each letter sent there is a financial cost to Woods Landing and an upset owner. Please don't be in a position to get a letter.

Pool – Our pool is looking at its best and even though the water is still on the cold side, it's a great place to gather or read a good book. The pool, lounge chairs, tables and bathrooms are being cleaned Monday, Wednesday and Friday. They use a antibacterial cleaner on all surfaces doing all possible to keep "germs" away. Trash – Trash pick up is Tuesday and Friday. Trash is put out for pick up the morning of pick up. Not the night before per Woods Landing CC&Rs. Trash cans with a tight lid should be used.
